Completing and submitting an application does not mean that your child is automatically in the tutoring program. You must be notified by one of the tutoring providers of your child's acceptance and start date. students and some can serve ELL or English Language Learners (See\*\*). You should be contacted by the provider that you select within three (3) working days from the time that the registration/application form is submitted to the District Office of Federal Programs. Your child's tutoring should begin immediately afterwards. Failure to attend the tutoring sessions will jeopardize your child's placement in the tutoring program. **Do not assume that submitting an application is a guarantee that your child is in free tutoring. You must be contacted by the selected provider about the official tutoring start date before you can send your child to tutoring.** All eligible students will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis until the SES 2010-11 allocation is exhausted or your child's PPA is exhausted.
